About our college's response to the new coronavirus infection

At our school, we started distance learning in April, and since June we have been conducting both face-to-face and distance learning. After adjusting the academic schedule and timetable, class hours will be secured in all curriculums, and both new students and current students will be able to complete the curriculum and graduate certification for each grade without any problems. Also, regarding job hunting, we are coordinating with new job-hunting activities such as online interviews, and although the situation is difficult, we are developing vigorous job-hunting activities.

At our college, based on notifications and information from the government, the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, etc., giving top priority to "safety of students, faculty members and all parties involved in our college", we will continue to strive to prevent the spread of infection in various ways.

(1) Infectious disease countermeasures at our college

○ Temperature measurement and hand disinfection at the college entrance

- A temperature gauge is set up at the entrance of the school building, and all enrollees are sterilized with alcohol on their hands and the temperature is measured by a fever detection thermal system by faculty and staff.

○ Reduction in student crowd by distributed attendance, using both classroom and online lessons (6/1~)

- Implementation of face-to-face lessons that are not crowded or intimate by separating college attendance dates and hours for new and current students.
- Conducting integrated lessons that combine face-to-face lessons and home study.

○ Wearing mask, ventilation and thorough disinfection

- Thorough wearing of masks in the classroom
- Thorough ventilation during and between classes
- Thorough disinfection work by teachers and students after using the classroom
